Here are some gentle reminders to get us all into good habits again:

- School starts at 9.00 and children need to be ready to start at 9.00. Our registers close at 9.05 (please see the letter we sent out on Tuesday for more information)
- In this cold weather, all children need to wear full winter uniform and have a suitable coat. Hats, scarves and gloves may be needed too. Please remember that every item of clothing needs to be named in case it gets lost.
- Year 3 and Year 5 are swimming this term—please remember your swimming kits on a Thursday
- School PE kits need to be in school ready for PE lessons—please check with your child's classteacher which day(s) that will be
- Children all have red reading diaries to help them to read at home. Please read with your child, or encourage them (if they are older) to read themselves. It makes a huge difference to every curriculum subject.
- School finishes at 3.15 for all children, unless they are in a club. Please come and collect your children promptly, and check the finishing times of clubs as necessary.
- Please ensure your child has a healthy breakfast before school, so they are alert and ready to learn, and if they have a packed lunch please make sure that is healthy too. Sandwiches, pasta, salads, yoghurts, fruit and cereal bars are all appropriate items for a lunch box. Please avoid chocolate, crisps, fizzy drinks and any fast food. Thank you very much.
