On Wednesday, children from Year 2 and 5 went to Kidzania in Westfield to discover a range of future careers, including TV and radio presenting, catering and banking.



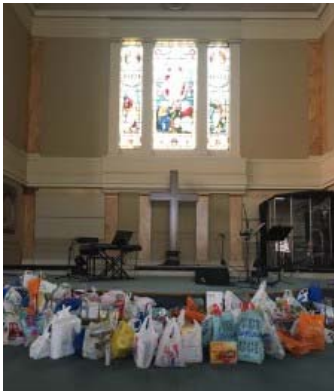
### FREE Parenting Course for St Mary's
