

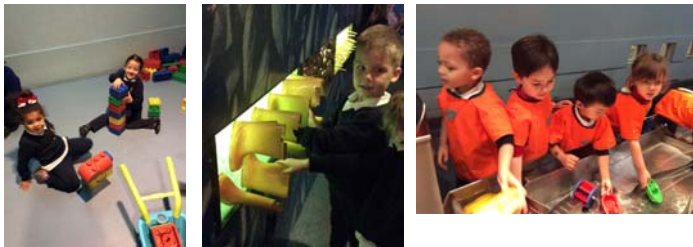

F1 Trip to the Science Museum

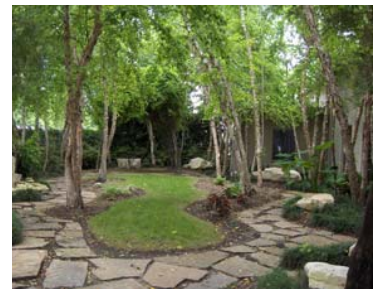

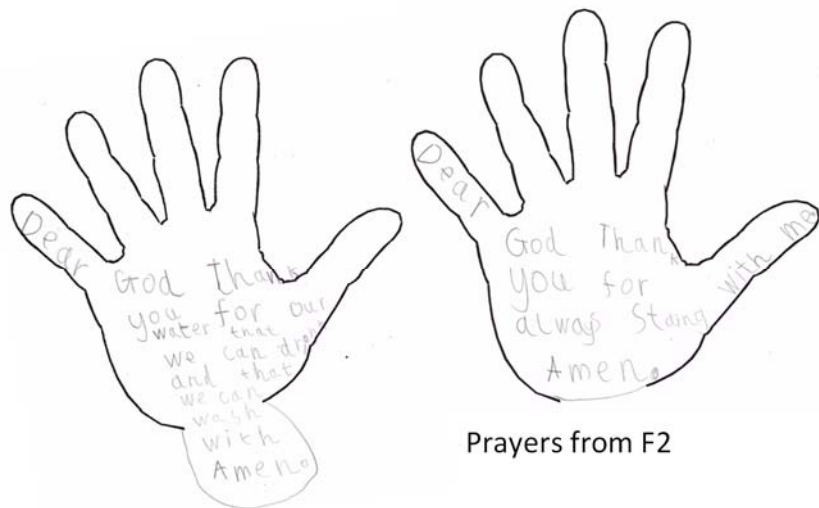
