### SATs Results 2017

We are very pleased with all our children for working hard in their SATs tests.

#### In Year 2:

Reading: 83% achieved the expected standard or above

Writing: 75% achieved the expected standard or above

Maths: 83% achieved the expected standard or above

Science: 83% achieved the expected standard

#### In Year 6:

Reading: 83% achieved the expected standard or above

Writing: 90% achieved the expected standard or above

EGPS: 97% achieved the expected standard or above

Maths: 69% achieved the expected standard or above

These results are all improvements on last year's results, which is great. Of course, we are always thinking about how we can improve further!
